## Resolutions for the Upcoming Constitutional Convention

The resolutions we are currently receiving are for the Constitutional Convention that deals with changes that are found in the UAW Constitution. The Constitution of the UAW is the highest law of our Union. The Constitution provides the basis for our day to day Local Union operations. It sets the rights for our members. It also addresses: Community Action Programs, Civil and Human Rights, Education, Strikes, Dues, Referendum, Health Care, Retirees, Trade Policies and the duties of International and Local Union Officers and its Committees.

Future Conventions will address Bargaining and Contractual changes prior to the next set of Negotiations and we will gather resolutions for that at a future date. If you submit a contractual change and not a constitutional change we will hold it for the next special convention on collective bargaining. The delegates you elect will be involved in both the Constitutional and the future Bargaining Conventions. The membership will adopt the resolutions at a Special Meeting on April 23<sup>rd</sup> 2018 at 3:10 PM at the Union Hall.
