2018 Apprenticeship Waitlist Classes

The UAW/Ford Joint Apprenticeship Committee will be offering Industrial Readiness Certificate Program Classes onsite in our Learning Center. Available to full-time in progression and legacy employees. Classes are paid for with your ETAP funds. Classes will be Tuesdays and Thursdays 4 pm to 8 pm, beginning September 11, 2018 and ending December 13, 2018.

If we have enough sign-ups we will also have classes Mondays and Wednesdays from 8 am to 12 noon. These classes will begin September 10, 2018 and ending December 12, 2018

Completion of these 3 classes are the only way to get on our apprenticeship waitlist. Currently 65 of our UAW Trades people have more than 40 years of Ford service. New apprentices start at over \$30/hr. with raises every 1000 shop hours. Current journeyman wages are over \$34/hr. The time is now to invest in your future.

Sign-up sheet and IRCP Program Information Flyers will be at the Employee Service Center mailboxes, located behind the Production Job Postings Board, south side of the V6 Assembly Offices. I will contact people from the signup sheet to begin the tuition assistance process once we have enough people for each class.
