V6 Layoff

Beginning on March 25th 2019 the V6 Assembly line, Turbo and Block line will be laid off for one week. The **Mass Layoff number** is: **1900160** when applying for unemployment benefits, please put **Friday 3/22/19 as your last day worked** even if you are scheduled and work on Saturday 3/23/19. Anyone working on 3/24/19 will not need to file because you will receive short work week.

The I-4 will still have a layoff beginning April 1st 2019 through April 5th 2019 and will have a different Mass Layoff number. This information will be provided to you next week.

Parking Policy

The Company has informed us that the Parking lot policy of non-Ford products will be strictly enforced. If you park an import or non-Ford vehicle in a designated preferred parking area for Ford/Lincoln products, you will be towed.

Work Safety

There has been an uptick in injuries recently so we are asking that you make sure you have the proper tools and personal protective equipment to perform your job. Do not be rushed or allow someone to rush you that makes you lose your concentration that may lead to an injury. You should leave work in the same condition you came. If you do not have the proper tools or personal protective equipment or if you are being assigned any potentially unsafe act, please request your union representative immediately.

TPT Reporting

All I-4 TPT's report on your normal day and shift the week of March 25th 2019, at minimum, you will receive a 1/10th pay to ensure you get credit toward your week. You may file for unemployment from lost wages, **you cannot use the mass layoff number**, and you must make sure you claim any earnings. All V6 TPT's will report next week to Market C on your normal day and on your normal start times. You will also, at minimum, get 1/10th credit and you may also file for unemployment.
