


## U.A.W. LOCAL 1250 WALLEYE TOURNAMENT

U.A.W. LOCAL 1250 WALLEYE TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES Anyone violating any of these guidelines may forfeit all prize money and raffle prizes won and may be unable to participate in future Walleye Tournaments.

- 1. There will be a cutoff of 30 boats.
- 2. No charters or charter captains who are for hire will be permitted.
- 3. Boats may leave their port on Sunday, June 23rd at 3:00 AM, and Walleye must be checked in by 3:00 PM on Sunday, June 23, 2019. A walleye committee member will be standing at the end of the line, to indicate cut-off point. No entries accepted after the cut-off point.

## 4. No Walleye will be checked in after 3:00 PM on Sunday, June 23, 2019

- 5. All waters of Lake Erie are open.
- 6. Maximum of four to a boat. One person must be a UAW Local 1250 Member.
- 7. First and Second place will be determined by total inches of your six longest Walleye. Third Prize will be given to the person who catches the longest Walleye of the day on Sunday, June 23, 2019. This Walleye may also be used in total length.
- 8. In the event of a tie on the top six (6) Walleye, the largest one will be the breaker.
- 9. Any Walleye turned in with a broken spine will be disqualified.
- 10. **Only** if a tie should occur on the longest Walleye, the weight of the Walleye will be the tiebreaker.
- 11. **RAIN OR SHINE** Dinner and door prizes will be held at 3:30 PM at Blue Ribbon Hall, located at 1023 Main Street in Huron, Ohio. Make sure you know where this is.
