1. ACTIVE EMPLOYEE'S, INCLUDING TPT AND STS ELIGIBILITY –

All Active Members in good standing are eligible to vote for: The UAW Local 1250 Executive Board Officers, (i.e., President, Vice President, Recording Secretary, Financial Secretary, Trustee's, Executive Board-At-Large, Sgt.-At-Arms) CEP 1 Building Chairperson, Bargaining Committeeperson, Committeepersons

ACTIVE SKILLED TRADES ELIGIBILITY- All Active Skilled Trades Members in good standing are eligible to vote for: The UAW Local 1250 Executive Board Officers, (i.e., President, Vice President, Recording Secretary, Financial Secretary, Trustee's, Executive Board-At-Large, Sgt.-At-Arms) CEP 1 Building Chairperson, Bargaining Committeeperson, Committeepersons, Skilled Trades Chairperson and Sub #3 Delegate)

RETIREE ELIGIBILITY – UAW Local 1250 Retirees are eligible to vote for: The UAW Local 1250 Executive Board Officers, (i.e., President, Vice President, Recording Secretary, Financial Secretary, Trustee's, Executive Board-At-Large, Sgt.-At-Arms and Retiree At Large) Retirees will also be voting for The UAW Local 1250 Retiree Chapter Officers (i.e., Chairman, Co-Chairman, Recording Secretary; Financial Secretary and Sgt..-At-Arms)

LEADEC ELIGIBILITY - All Leadec Members in good standing are eligible to vote for: The UAW Local 1250 Executive Board Officers, (i.e., President, Vice President, Recording Secretary, Financial Secretary, Trustee's, Executive Board-At-Large, Sgt..-At-Arms) Leadec Stewards.

NURSE ELIGIBILITY - All Nurse Members in good standing are eligible to vote for: The UAW Local 1250 Executive Board Officers, (i.e., President, Vice President, Recording Secretary, Financial Secretary, Trustee's, Executive Board-At-Large, Sgt.-At-Arms) Nurse Chairperson.

- 2. You **MUST** have a picture I.D. to vote.
- 3. You will **REGISTER** to vote by the **Plant you are working in.** Have your I.D. ready.
- 4. Voters who have already voted, **will not loiter** within the voting area (which means the voting area in the hall or parking lot)
- 5. **DRIVERS** who wish to haul voters can drop voters off and pick them up after they vote. No driver will be allowed out of the car or van. If you have union business, park at the south end of the building.
- 6. **No campaign posters or literature** will be allowed to be passed out on the local union property (inside or outside the building) by membership action.
- 7. There will be no **INTIMIDATION** of any of the Election Committee Members.
- 8. There will be no **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES** in, or about, the Election Hall.
- 9. Same rules above will apply in the event of a **RUN-OFF**.

RULES GOVERNING CHALLENGERS

- 1. Names of **CHALLENGERS** must be submitted to the Election Committee no later than **2:00 PM on Wednesday**, **June 24**, **2020 at the Local Union Hall.** Challengers must be a member of the Local Union. (Art. 38, Sec. 10g) No names shall be accepted after this date. A drop off box will be in the lobby of the UAW Local 1250 Union Hall.
- 2. During the voting period of **July 22 & 23, 2020**, no **Challenger** has the right to interfere with any voter. Also, no challenger will be allowed to wave or talk to voters. No **interference** of any kind will be allowed.
- 3. No challengers will be allowed to campaign in the voting area. (Which means the voting area in the Union Hall or Parking Lot.)
- 4. No challenger is allowed to be present when two (2) Election Workers are assisting a voter who asked for help in voting.
- 5. At no time will a challenger be permitted to assist a voter or show them how to vote on the machines.
- 6. **A Challenger's job is to oversee** the election, not to sit up front and welcome people coming to vote. This **WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.** Any challenger not following instructions from the Election Committee will be removed from being a challenger for the duration of the election. **This will be enforced.**
- 7. All candidates are responsible for their challenger. A challenger is not a campaigner. If the challenger is caught campaigning, they will be removed from being a challenger for the duration of the election.
- 8. During the voting, counting, and tabulating, no challenger is permitted to **handle** any equipment that pertains to the election. Each Challenger authorized by a candidate to be present for the tally will be required to sign in and remain until the final tally results are announced by the Election Committee Chairperson.
