<u> COVID Hourly Pay Scenario – <mark>Effective, Tuesday, September 6, 2022</mark></u>

* Scenario 1(a) revised eligibility for up to 5 calendar days' unlimited occurrence use of base schedule pay while employee is in isolation with COVID-19.

* Employee must show positive PCR test to substantiate his/her five absence days.

* The test must be a professional antigen test. In other words, the test must be performed at a pharmacy, urgent care, doctor's office, etc. and cannot be a home test. An antigen test that is proctored through a telemedicine visit is acceptable as well.

* Scenario 1(c) (formerly Scenario 2): Removed Scenario for employee who is "Close Contact with Confirmed case in the workplace".

* Employees who are subject to quarantine due to being a Close Contact inside the Workplace are no longer eligible for replacement wages/pay.

<u>3% Base Wage Increase</u>

Base Wage Increase (Applied to Top rate and Grow-in rates) 3% September 2022.

Article IX - Wages and other economic Matters

Section 2.

Wage Rate Increases (a) General Wage Increase

- (i) Employees whose straight time base hourly wage rate was \$29.52 or more as of the effective date of this agreement shall receive a three percent (3%) increase added to their base wage rate on September 14, 2020.
- (ii) Effective September 19, 2022, employees who were eligible for a base wage increase according to Section 2 (a) (i) shall receive a second base wage increase of three percent (3%) increase added to their base wage rate.

The General Wage Increase will not be applied to the "increment above" portion of classification pay rates.
