***YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO SIGN IN AND OUT DAILY. YOUR TIME WILL NOT BE MONITORED, BUT WILL HELP US IN CASE COVID TRACING IS NEEDED.**

***MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES REGARDLESS OF VACCINATION STATUS.**

***PARTICIPANTS MUST PRACTICE SOCIAL DISTANCING OF 6 FEET AT ALL TIMES.**

***POSTED CAPACITY LIMITS AND HOURS OF OPERATION MUST BE ADHERED TO.**
