ED FAIR UPDATE - PARKING

As you are aware, on September 7th 2017 we will hold an Education/Health Care Fair for all of our members. Reminiscent of years ago, it will be held in a tent in front of the gate where you first enter into the plant. Because of the placement of the tent to make it more convenient for our members, we must have the area where the motorcycles park cleared on Sunday September 3, 2017, On Tuesday morning (September 5th 2017), the tent will be set up as we prepare for the event. Parking in that area will resume Friday afternoon on September 8th 2017.

The event will begin at 6 AM and continue through 6 PM, this is a reminder that on this day, food will be provided for you. The Educational Fair Promotional gift will be given out to all the active members, this will include all TPT and STS employees, please have your Ford ID available for us to checkoff your receiving the gift. Collection to Help Those Affected by Hurricane Harvey

3% Wage Increase

Effective September 17th 2017, traditional employees will receive a 3% wage increase. In Progression employees receive their wage increases on each of their seniority anniversary dates. Temporary employees pay rate progressions are spelled out in the 2015 National Agreement.

Support for UAW Local 2192

During this week, committee and staff members will be asking for you to sign a petition of support for our fellow UAW brothers and sisters from Local 2192 who are over Jobs and Family services, the Commissioners who have been in negotiations with them the past 11 months are proposing significant increases to their health care. This added cost is being added through a surcharge or a “carve out” charge to employees that have their spouse on their coverage. The Lorain county Commissioners have refused to supply the UAW negotiators with information on what the health care costs will be, no one can be expected to sign a blank check for the cost of their healthcare. No matter what county you live in, you can sign the petition supporting the UAW workers in their efforts to negotiate a fair agreement.
