2020 Inflation Protection Bonus

Eligible hourly employees will receive the 2020 Inflation Bonus Lump Sum Payment of \$1500 during week ending June 14th 2020. Full time hourly employees on the active employment roll are eligible if they have acquired seniority (completed their 90 day probationary period) as of May 15th 2020. It has been agreed between National Ford & Labor Affairs that our 25 newest employees converted to full time will also receive this bonus.

Temporary Full Time non seniority employees are not eligible for an inflation Bonus Lump Sum Payment.

Eligible seniority employees on the active roll on personal or medical leave of absence, FMLA leave, temporary layoff, or short-term military duty on May 15th, 2020 will receive an Inflation Bonus Lump Sum Payment.

The Inflation Bonus Lump Sum Payment will be paid in a separate check and will be either direct deposited or mailed to the employees address on record during the week ending June 14th, 2020. The TESPHE election is available for this payment.

Assembly Shut Down Weeks

The Shutdown weeks for Cleveland Engine are as follows:

I-4: Weeks of June 29th and August 17th 2020

V-6: Weeks of September 28th and October 19th 2020

(OVER)

The I-4 Assembly line plan is to stay on 2 shifts for the remainder of the year, at times they will be scheduled on 9 hours a day as the demand requirements dictate. The V-6 Assembly line will currently stay on 2 shifts and at times may go on a nine hour shift as demand dictates as well. As of now, we have not been given a date on the return of the midnight shift.

Crank Line Schedule

The Crank Line will resume its 4 Crew schedule on Monday June 1st 2020. We are still in discussions on future Shift/Crew Patterns.

Head Machining

It is anticipated that the Head Machining will be adding a third Crew back into its schedule mid-June.

Block line

The Block line will be going on 2 shifts beginning on June 1st 2020 with occasional overtime as needed.
