MASS LAY-OFF NUMBER

The Union recently sat with the Company to make a letter to clarify the mass lay-off numbers and vacation pay. Please pay particular attention to the Company document if you work in the I-4 area or are a low seniority employee with limited vacation. We tried to capture examples for all employees, please follow the instructions as outlined on the Company Leaflet. If you have any questions please contact a union official. Some employees will need to file twice with 2 different lay-off numbers.

SUMMER SHUTDOWN

Summer shutdown 2017 will be the weeks of July 3 -7th and July 10 – 14th. This will be for the entire plant except for most skilled trades and a limited number of production. The I-4 side will also be down for the week of July 17-21st, 2017. Also, the west crank line will be down in August for 5 weeks. Those weeks and the reduction plan will be discussed in a future leaflet.

The city withholdings codes are set up by Ford Motor Company Corporate Payroll and is based on the city worked and the city of residence. Not every combination of city of work and city of residence is represented. Employees can email hrpay@ford.com to see if Ford Motor Company Corporate Payroll is willing to establish a new local tax withholding code for their district and place of employment. The more employees residing in Lorain who email, the better chance of achieving this new withholding.
