Benefits Information

Sterling life and disability open enrollment will be from April 22, 2019 – May 31, 2019 during this time you will be able to increase your coverage by one level without going thru approval process with your doctor.

Medical Mutual of Ohio – changes starting as of May 1, 2019. This coverage will no longer allow you to use doctors out of town, but you will still be able to use an Emergency Room for Emergency situations only.

If you have this insurance you should have received a letter explaining the changes, if you wish to change your insurance you can do so as we have a rolling enrollment.
