Things will look vastly different on the shop floor, the changes are a result of the guidance information from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), World Health Organization (WHO) and the Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA). We realize that any change is difficult but this too shall pass and before you know it we will get back to some type of new normalcy.

As many of you have read on social media, the dayshift is beginning today on May 18th 2020 with the afternoon shift starting up in the beginning of June. This will be a phased start up that may take a while to ramp up to full speed. A recent 60 Minutes television episode showed how our UAW workers were on the front line preparing masks, face shields and ventilators. We are proud of all the UAW members who were involved in this effort to save lives and we grieve for the families that lost loved ones during this pandemic.

New TFT Hiring

The final step of the Preferential Placement Hierarchy was completed. Five out of zone skilled tradesmen elected to come to CEP1 as production workers. **This means that 25 TFT's will now transition to in-progression full time status in the very near future.** This is in addition to the 107 TFT's recently converted to in-progression. These additional 25 in-progression conversion employees will also be eligible for the remainder of the \$9000.00 signing bonus (\$5500.00).
