Down Weeks

The Company has informed the Local Union of upcoming down weeks in the I-4 Assembly, during the weeks of:

September 11 – 15, 2017

October 16 – 20, 2017

These down weeks are due to facility conversion for the Maverick Engine Upgrade. The V6 side will also be taking 2 down ***shifts*** the week of:

September 11 – 15, 2017

Management has agreed to work 1st Shift only on the V6 side during that week. The down shift in V6 are due to Kentucky Truck taking extended down weeks while we continued to build. This caused a build-up of inventory and now the Company needs to adjust. The management team still contends there is high demand for the 4th quarter.

We will post your layoff status election in the plant by Market C, all committeeman will also have a copy. The last day to change your status for the September layoff is Monday, August 28, 2017.

TPT-STS

Per the National Agreement, the Summer STS window placement will be closing. Therefore, all STS Employees will be placed on TPT Status starting the week of September 11, 2017. There has been an ongoing issue with the seniority lists in the plant for STS-TPT. We have been monitoring the lists daily and weekly. There has been stability added in that no TPT's have been allowed to work more than 3 days, which caused employees to jump higher on the list. The other issue causing changes in the order is down weeks in the I4 & V6. We are currently working on a resolution with the Company on this issue. If anyone would like an audit of their weeks we will conduct an audit for you. We have audits being reviewed by the National Ford Department now, due to pay adjustments affecting weeks worked.
